Pyotr Illyich Tchaikovsky

born on May 7, 1840, in Kamsko-Votkinsk



- The most popular Russian composer of all time who scripted many symphonies, concertos, operas, ballets, and chamber music
- At age four he made his first recorded attempt at composition, a song written with his younger sister
- He had an passion for music but his parents hoped that he would grow up to work in the civil service
- He started taking piano lessons from the age of five
- In three years he could read music as well as his teacher
- His family decided to send Tchaikovsky to the Imperial School of Jurisprudence in Saint Petersburg in 1850 for better life

In 1989, when he was 38 years old, he was inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame.

He is currently studying for a doctorate in mathematics in the USA

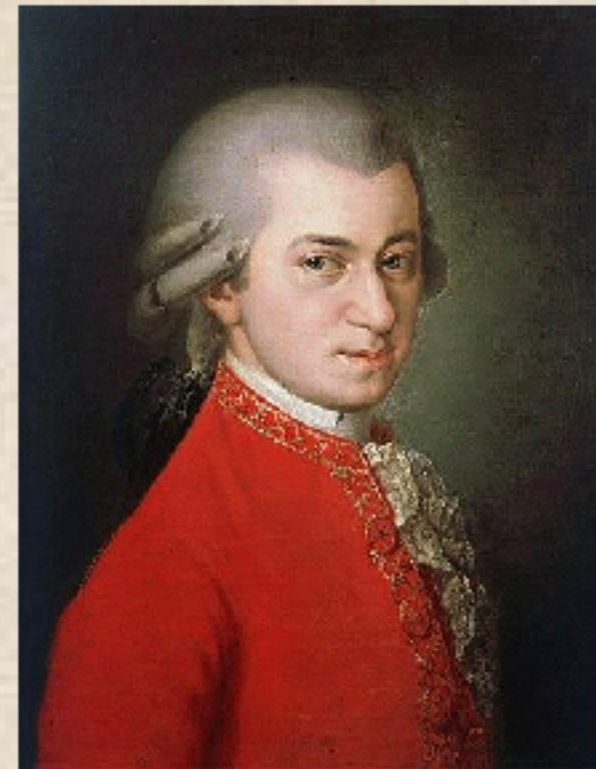


Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart

1756 Salzburg - 1791 Vienna



- composer of the Classical period
- he composed from the age of five
- he composed more than 600 works
- he is considered among the greatest classical composers of all time
- the most famous works are operas *The Marriage of Figaro* and *Don Giovanni*

Blase Pascal

- French mathematician, physicist, and philosopher in 17-th century
- wasn't taught math as a child
- educated privately by his father
- at age 12 he discovered angles and triangles
- 1640- Blase published his first mathematical work
- two years later he invented mechanical adding and subtracting device = first calculating machine
- he died at age 39 in 1662

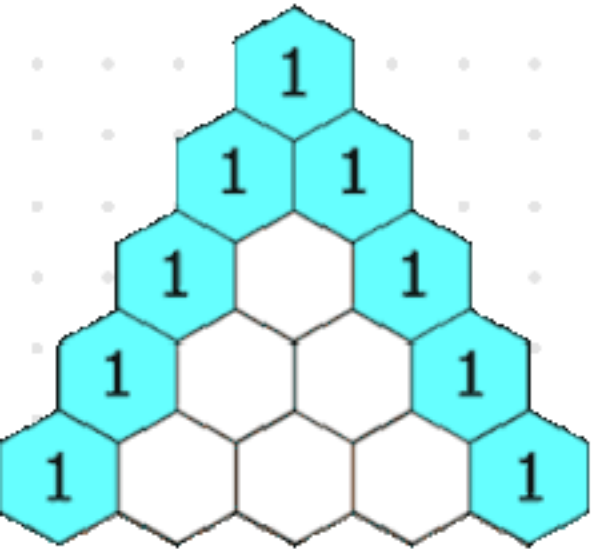

Blaise Pascal



Born in June 1623 in Clermont-Ferrand (France), lost his mother at the age of three, fascinated with mathematics and science since his childhood



His first works were the mystic hexagram and the pascaline - a small and relatively primitive calculator. Among his later works were the Pascals triangle, the probability theory, and the all important discovery of Pascals law



Blaise died in August of the year 1662 at the age of 39

John von Neumann

He was born on 28th of December 1903 in Budapest.

His most significant discovery was in the field of digital computers and the operational theory of quantum mechanics.

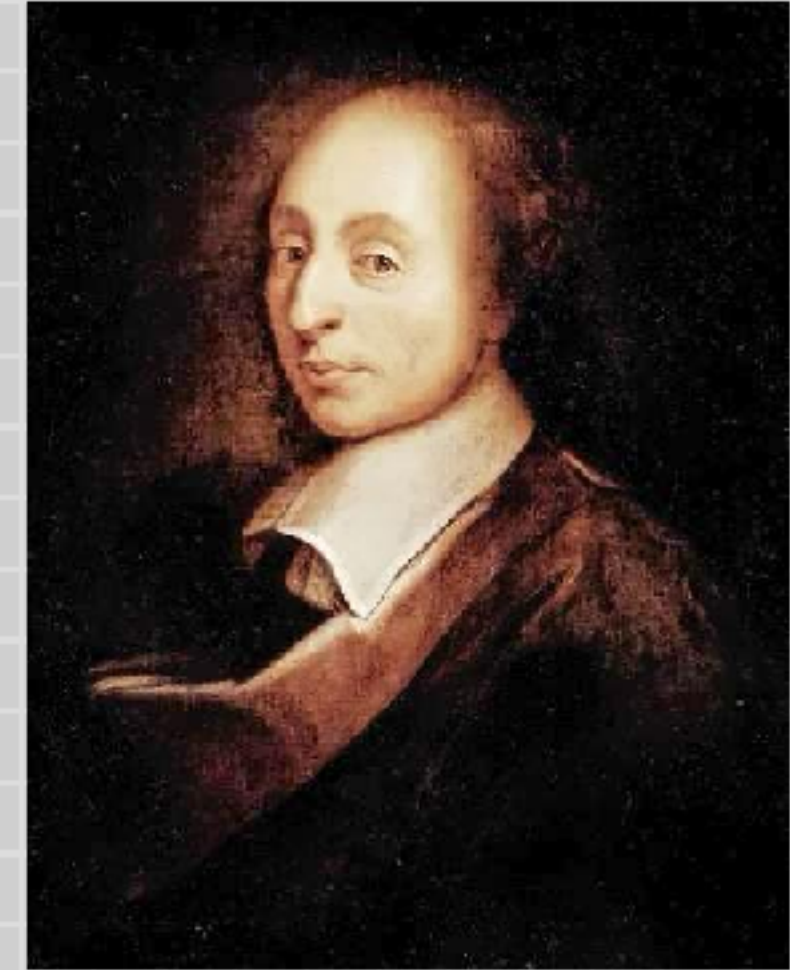
